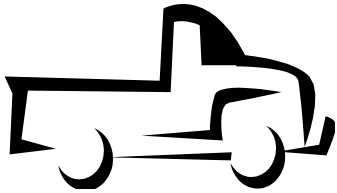


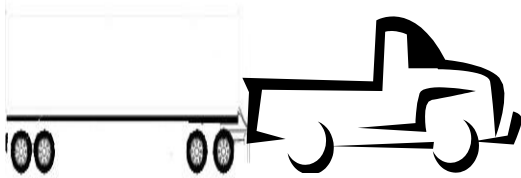
THIS FLYER HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY ODOT

The following USDOT regulations are enforced by ODOT and apply to vehicles used to transport fruit.



Pickup truck

If the GVWR is less than 10,000 pounds, the vehicle is EXEMPT from USDOT, UCR and driver medical card requirements.



Pickup truck with a trailer

If the combined GVWR of the pickup and the trailer exceeds 10,000 pounds, the following is required:

- USDOT Number and UCR Registration
- A medical card is required

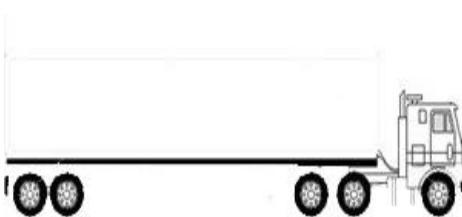


Flat-bed Truck

If the GVWR exceeds 10,000 pounds, the following is required:

- USDOT Number and UCR Registration

A medical card is NOT required



Tractor with trailer

If the GVWR exceeds 10,000 pounds, the following is required:

- USDOT Number and UCR Registration
- A medical card is required

Visit your personal physician for your medical card

The USDOT number and legal name of the operation must be on each side of the vehicle. The numbers and name must contrast with the color of the vehicle and be legible at 50 feet. The vehicle must receive a yearly safety inspection by a certified mechanic.
